

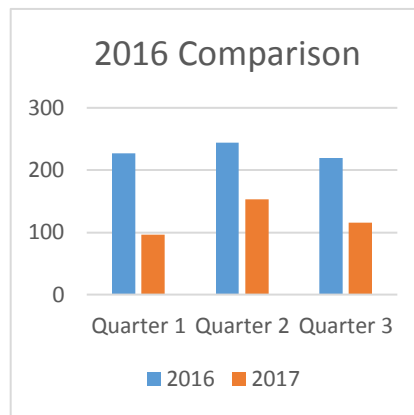

Positive changes are happening at GHS. Over the course of the year we have monitored the implementation of our Academic Assistance program and the impact on the number of courses failed. Each Quarter we collect data and compare it to last year. I would like to share some of that data with you. In the chart to the right you can see the reduction in the number of failures compared to last year, Quarter one the number of courses failed was reduced by 58%. Quarter two by 37% and Quarter three by 47% for a total reduction of 47% this year.
