- Two letters of recommendation: 1 from a high school teacher who has worked with the student in the classroom; 1 from another person who is familiar with the student but who has not been his/her teacher and who is not a relative (examples: coach, club advisor, minister, employer, etc.)
- Essay (approximately 500 words) that addresses the following prompt:

Unfortunately, he lost his battle; however, he did not define himself by his cancer. Instead, he had a passion for people and was loyal beyond measure.
